Remote surveillance to improve security

CCTVs worth RM500,000 to be installed at Johor Halal Park

PASIR GUDANG: Johor Halal Park (JHP) will instal a total of 34 closed-circuit television cameras (CCTVs) within the park to enhance security on its premises.

JHP chief executive officer Mohd Noor Abdul Salam said that the installation of the RM500,000 worth of units on the 50-acre land was expected to be completed by next year, providing the latest technology which includes the ability to zoom in up to a 150m radius.

"The units will be able to view vehicle registration numbers' in a bid to monitor vehicles entering and exiting the park," he said.

He added that the units would also be able to capture clear video footages even at night with its high definition (HD) bullet camera.

He said this during the JHP first phase development briefing on Sept 15.

"We want the foreign investors to have a high level of confidence when collaborating with our park and hence the reason for installing the CCTVs," Mohd Noor said.

He added that security and safety measures were the most important factors for investors and the park would continue to beef up its security system within the area to ensure that safety was maintained.

"JHP is also in the process of collaborating with the Seri Alam district police headquarters to monitor the park's area, especially at night," he said.

He added that some of the collaborations with the police will include connecting the live CCTV feed to the Seri Alam district police headquarters for monitoring as

well as setting up booths for the police to monitor the area.

"The booths will be set up next year and the police personnel can conduct their patrol activities within the park with convenience," he said.

Seri Alam OCPD Supt Johkiri Abd Aziz said in the meantime, the police would carry out their patrol duty as usual in Pasir Gudang.

"The installation of the CCTV is a good way to monitor the surroundings, especially at industrial areas and I hope foreign investors will have more confidence," he said.
